About Us

Middlesex County Area Transit (MCAT) is the passenger transportation office of Middlesex County Department of Transportation (MCDOT). MCAT provides transportation for senior citizens, persons with disabilities and the general public.

Advance Reservation Based Service

MCAT provides transportation with a fee of \$3.00 per trip (one way), to seniors 60+ and disabled residents of Middlesex County. The general purpose of the program is to make intermittent transportation available and accessible so that residents may obtain the necessities of life. Advanced registration, reservation and prepurchase of tickets are required.

Transportation Parameters

- Individuals must have a scheduled appointment in order to register and reserve transportation with MCAT.
- Tickets must be pre-purchased in advance.
- Transportation may be requested months in advance no less than three (3) full business days (not including weekends) before your scheduled appointment.
- Transportation is based on availability and a shared ride with other passengers.
- Transportation is curb-to-curb.
 Drivers are not permitted to assist passengers beyond the curb.
- Transportation is provided within Middlesex County and up to 5 miles outside the County excluding Dialysis.
- Dialysis transportation is provided to Middlesex County locations only.

- Requests for service will be met as resources permit.
- Veterans' transportation is available twice a week to <u>Lyons</u> <u>Hospital</u> on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- Veterans' transportation is available three times a week to <u>East Orange Hospital</u> on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
- Veterans' transportation is available Monday through Friday to medical facilities within Middlesex County.

Middlesex County Community Program

Provides a Deviated Route Shuttle Service, which do not require advance reservation for the general public. There is a suggested fare \$1.00 for General Public and \$.50 for Seniors and Disabled.
