Certificate of Insurance Requirements

Thank you for your interest in reserving a Middlesex County Parks & Recreation facility. All permit applicants must provide a Certificate of Insurance to receive permit approval according to the requirements listed below. The County of Middlesex assumes no liability with respect to bodily injury, property damage, illness or any other damages or losses, or with respect to any claims arising out of any activity of the permit holder.

1. The County of Middlesex requires the applicant to procure and continue in force for the term identified on the permit Commercial General Liability insurance with minimum limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence/\$2,000,000 aggregate
2. The policy must include contractual liability coverage.
3. **Please insert this language in the Description of Operations block on the Certificate:**
 - **Permit holders name and/or household** number must be listed.
 - **Additional Insured:** The County of Middlesex, its officers, officials, employees, and volunteers shall be named as an Additional Insured.
4. Policy shall provide that coverage shall not be canceled, except with notice to the County.
5. **The Certificate Holder box shall be identified as:** County of Middlesex

A). Special Event Permit Holders must provide a Certificate of Commercial General Liability insurance with the requirements listed above.

B). Separate Certificates of Insurance are required by customers who hire a vendor or vendors for their event, i.e., Food Caterers, etc. The vendor must submit a Certificate of Commercial General Liability Insurance with the requirements listed above.
FOOD TRUCK VENDORS- Automobile Liability: Coverage for all owned, non-owned and hired vehicles with limits not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, combines single limits (CSL) or its equivalent.

C). **Certificates of Insurance MUST** accompany your completed Fire Marshal application by three business days prior to your picnic or event.

****Certificates of Insurance must be approved by the Reservations Office ONLY and will not be approved by the Park Rangers or the Middlesex County Fire Marshal. Any discrepancy between the information on the insurance certificate and the permit application information will result in a delay in processing your application and/or denial of a permit****
