Redistricting

The Old Bridge and Piscataway Municipal Clerks reviewed the redistricting maps and had no objections. Knowink confirmed that an A & B scenario is feasible in the Statewide Voter Registration System (SVRS). Administrator Lynch reached out to the Attorney General’s Office concerning the request for a court order, however he has not heard back. Nicholas Phelan from Remington and Vernick reviewed the Piscataway redistricting map. He indicated that based on the number of registered voters, the districts are compliant as proposed. Motion was made by Comm. Moskowitz to adopt the Piscataway redistricting map as presented. Motion was seconded by Comm. Frankel. Voice vote 6-0.

Mr. Phelan proceeded to review the Old Bridge redistricting map. He indicated that all districts are compliant. Comm. Katz suggested that the Board adopt the Old Bridge map as is with an A & B scenario and then ask the Attorney General to request a court order to eliminate the micro districts. Comm. Frankel stated that although he is not totally against the A & B scenario he would prefer a numerical sequence, which in his opinion would be less confusing for voters and poll workers. Motion was made by Comm. Katz to adopt the Old Bridge redistricting map as presented. Motion was seconded by Comm. Bengivenga. Voice vote 5-1. Comm. Frankel voted no.
