The Middlesex County Improvement Authority's Program (MCIA) collects recyclables in single-stream fashion. All curbside recyclable items, such as bottles, cans, paper, and small flat cardboard can be mixed together in a single recycling container. Do not put recycling in bags. **WE DO NOT ACCEPT PLASTIC BAGS.**
