

PANCREATIC CANCER SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES



Key things to remember!

- 1. Please refer to "Softball League Rules and Regulations" for a complete list of all rules.
- 2. Please check in at field #1 at least 30 minutes prior to your first game. All rosters must be must be completed and will be reviewed at this time.
- **3.** Each team will pay \$30.00 in CASH to the umpires for each game with the exception of the semi-final and final!
- **4.** Only ASA approved aluminum Bats are permitted. No composite or titanium bats whatsoever may be used in league play even if they are ASA approved. Composite handles are OK as long as it appears on the ASA approved bat list as either a Single-Wall or Multi-Wall.

- **5.** Nine (9) Players are needed to start the game. Three (3) must be female. Don't forget a catcher's mask!
- 6. If a team is only playing 3 females, the team must utilize a male player in the catcher's position. An alternate male-female batting order must be used. If a team has (4) four or more female players, then a female catcher can be utilized. All male batters who walk will be awarded 2nd base. Runners who are already on base will advance two (2) bases only if forced.
 - (Note: if you are playing with only three (3) female players and have no other rostered females available and one gets injured and/or can't continue playing, you can finish that game with 2 female players. That player's spot in the batting order will become an automatic out. If you have another game to play, you can't start the game with 2 female players and the game will be forfeited.)
- **7.** Keep your foot on the base until the batter makes contact with the ball. You will be called out if not!

Most importantly, have fun! This is all for charity!
