- Responsible for cash handling, cash withdrawal, ensuring change recycler is full in cash pay station.
- Analysis critical parking and traffic data to provide guidance in future business making decisions.
- · Perform routine audits, including revenue, PARCS system, and operational audits
- Create necessary monthly operational and financial reports
- Advise director on any departmental needs, make recommendations to improve parking operations
- Planning and management of irregular operational events including snow removal and other emergencies
